II. Financial Commitment

The RE program is paid for primarily through annual pledges to the congregation by members and friends of our church. If you are attending regularly but not yet making a pledge, we encourage you to do so! Pledge cards are always available in the church office. If you are not yet ready to make that commitment to the church, we ask that you pay a registration fee to offset some of the costs of supplies and materials. **Please indicate below how you choose to financially support the RE Program:**

Volunteer Opportunity Descriptions

RE Teacher: Plans and leads lessons 1-2 times per month. Training, curriculum, supplies and ongoing support are provided. Total commitment is about 12-14 Sundays during the church year. Requires a background check.

Classroom Assistant – Helps teacher as needed with supervision of children/youth one Sunday per month.

RE Council: Provide leadership and guidance for the Religious Education Program for Children and Youth. Participate in monthly meetings and perform additional tasks as needed to plan and implement religious education and special congregational events sponsored by the RE Department. Meetings will be scheduled on a weekday evening.

On Call Substitute: Leading any class when regular teachers are not available due to illness or scheduling conflicts. Called as needed – usually about 4-6 times during the year.

Congregational Social Events: Assist with set up, clean up, and activity supervision during 2 parties. Tentative event dates are: Saturdays Oct. 30, Nov. 20, Dec. 11, Jan. 29, April 9, and May 14.

Social Justice Projects for Elementary Youth – Attend and assist with 2 activities during Sunday morning RE. Tentative event dates are Sundays Sept. 26, Oct. 24, Nov. 21, Jan. 16, Feb. 13, March 20, April 17, May 15.

Worship Services for Elementary Youth - Attend and assist with 2 worship programs during Sunday morning RE. Tentative event dates are Sundays Oct. 31, Nov. 28, Jan. 23, Feb. 20, March 27, May 22.

Winter Solstice Program: Planning and support for worship service and supper. Committee convenes in October; task is complete following Solstice on Tuesday, December 21

Holiday Pageant: Planning and support for Holiday Pageant performance. Committee convenes in October; task is complete following Pageant on Sunday, December 20.

Easter Activities: Planning and support for annual Easter Egg Hunt. Committee convenes in March; task is complete after Easter Sunday on April 24th.

Youth Social Activities: Committee plans occasional social outings for 7-12th grade youth throughout the church year.

Youth Travel Fundraising: Committee assists 7-12th grade youth throughout the year planning fundraisers to support trips to conferences (CONS), High School Mission Trip, and Coming of Age Boston Trip.

Youth Travel Chaperone: Travel with and supervise 7-12th grade youth to weekend conferences (CONS), High School Mission Trip, and Coming of Age Boston Trip. Requires a background check.

Library Assistance: Help organize and catalog our RE library materials using an online service. Training will be provided in the fall. We request that you schedule about 6 hours of service.
